Further Notes

- Upon receiving the \$13,000 deposit, Rosthern Junior College will send the Letter of Acceptance necessary for immigration purposes to the Department of Canadian Immigration. The money will be credited to the student's account and will be subject to the policy above.
- Formal evaluation of the student's transcript may not occur until after classes have begun. An initial evaluation of their transcript, done by school administration and the Ministry of Education, will be used to determine class/course placement.

- A copy of medical approval and a copy of any immunizations and vaccination records are required before student will be accepted.
- A Canadian Custodian must be assigned to ALL students under the age of 18 studying abroad. If you do not have someone in Canada, please make note of this when applying.
